Moved to Canada (instead of Viet Nam) from Michigan at the age of 20 in 1969. In the 1970's was involved in Youth Work, largely with the YMCA of Metro Toronto. Initially running the Stopover Youth Hostel in the basement of the Central Y and setting up a program called Migrant Services to divert young men away from the downtown drug and prostitution scene. Was the Y's representative on the Toronto Youth Services Network. From 1975-79 ran the YMCA Action Service Contact Centre in south Etobicoke which was a community information service providing a wide range of services and community development activities.

From 1979-2023 was a licenced Real Estate Broker and Appraiser selling homes with Re/max in and around Mississauga (and a few in NOTL).

Moved to Niagara-on-the-Lake in May, 2010 and got active politically with local issues in 2012-2013 when (n)Evergreen Estates was planned and built behind our home on Shaw's and I was elected to the role of President of the Shaw's Lane Homeowner Association. Delegated and wrote letters concerning the old stables condo development by Solmar and Mary Street Condo applications.

Have been involved with SORE since 2017, campaigned for Betty Disero and Clare Cameron in the 2018 Municipal election and Betty again in 2022.

With my wife, Irene we organised and led the "Wake for the Trees" after Mr. Marotta clear cut the back half of the Rand Estate. Participated in the Seniors' Housing Committee from its inception and the NOTL Ratepayers(Residents) Association organizing committee from its inception in the summer of 2024. Active member of St. Vincent dePaul church in NOTL.
